And what it means for you

Current Structure

Membership at AFCPE runs on a calendar year, from January 1 to December 31.

Regardless of when you become a member, membership will expire on December 31.

Membership fees are not prorated based on when you join.

A note to AFCs

This change is not in reference to your annual certification fee (due June each year).

Membership is what provides you with free professional development and career enhancement opportunities.

Moving to an anniversary year means you can become a member in June and combine your membership fees with certification fees and still receive a full year of membership.

Anniversary Year - The Benefits

You will always receive a full year of member benefits no matter when you join. For example, if you become a member on September 15th, your renewal date will be September 15th of the following year.

You are able to build the cost of membership into your budget when it works for you! Or, if your organization is willing to cover the cost of membership, you can align it with their fiscal year.

This allows us to share the value of membership year round- attracting new professionals to our community.
