- 4. In the space provided below, please discuss the cost of the consumer information piece in relation to its perceived value.
- 5. Please discuss the authors' expertise, experience, and/or background of the consumer information piece.
- 6. Please discuss the innovativeness of the consumer information piece.
- 7. Please provide evidence of the resource's reach and impact. If available, include data, feedback, or examples of how it has benefited users.



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- 8. If possible, please include a copy of the article, periodical, book, consumer brochure, computer program, web pages, newsletter, or audio/visual medium for review by the committee. Place links to material below or attach the material as a separate document. If the material cannot be linked to, or attached as a separate document, please contact the awards committee for further information.
- 9. Attach relevant documentation as needed, not to exceed 10 pages total. (optional)
